

Title	Finding Appropriate Practices in Waste Management and Reducing Waste in Households in Sri Narong Subdistrict, Chumphon Buri District, Surin Province
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ABSTRACT

This research aims to the suitable practices in household waste management in Sri Narong Sub-district, Chumphon Buri District, Surin Province. And to reduce the amount of garbage collected in the community of Sri Narong. Chumphon Buri District Surin Province The data collected from the community was targeted at Ban Yang Noi community. There are 50 households in Chumphon Buri, Moo 13. It is a participatory action research (PAR).

The research found that: 1) The best practice in household waste management is "to create a community of waste management prototype from home in the household", which is a model that encourages people in the community. Leadership plays a very important role in doing the model, encouraging the community to do every household. And 2) Reducing the amount of household waste in the Sri Narong community, Chumphon Buri District, Surin Province found that 45 community members accounted for 90%. The activities were to reduce the amount of waste collected in the household into a model village in the waste management, including the separation of waste in the home itself, such as plastic bottles. Sell Household waste such as biodegradable plastic bags. There is no garbage in the household, the people in the household care and cleaning. Garbage collection in front of the house itself, the community has a community. Team work, rules and regulations, strong community leaders. Volunteer in waste management and reduce

the amount of waste collected in the household, the community to cooperate to manage their own garbage in every home, encouraging children and youth in the household to collect. Every Sunday of each week, waste plastic bags are used to burn household waste. No trash. The changes and community acquired within the community are the prototype communities in the field of waste management and reduce the amount of household waste. Awarded at the national level as a study tour. Provincial and external government agencies provide budget support and knowledge to undertake waste management activities and reduce household waste.
